

# City of the Village of Douglas

has curbside recycling collected every other week on Tuesdays. Items are placed in special Allied bags available at City Hall at 86 W. Center St. Look below for materials acceptable for recycling.

**Place papers in one bag and metals, glass and plastic in another bag and set out the *night before* collection.**

**Paperboard**—Cereal snack & tissue boxes, remove liners, no wax coated paperboard.

**Junk Mail**—Envelopes, flyers, brochures, post cards.

**Magazines, Phone Books & Catalogs Cardboard & Paper Bags**—Flatten cardboard & cut into pieces, no wax coated cardboard.

**Glass**—Empty clear, green or brown glass.  
**Metal**—Cans must be rinsed out, empty aerosol containers.

**Batteries**—Seal in Zip-loc bags, household only.

**Plastics**— #1 thru #5 and #7, plastic bottles and jugs, empty and rinsed out, plastic grocery bags #2 & #4

**Styrofoam #6 can not be recycled in the curbside program. Read below in other materials to find out where Styrofoam is accepted!**



Call the Allegan County Health Department if you have **Household Hazardous Waste**, like: **household batteries, oil-based paints, cleaners, expired or unwanted medications, pesticides,**

**solvents, compact fluorescent lights, automotive and other chemicals.** Bring us your **mercury thermometers** for an exchange! Appointments for drop off are available on Tuesdays and Thursdays during regular business hours. Call 269-673-5415 for your appointment.



**Used motor oil can be recycled!** Call **Fennville Tire Center**, 205 W. Main, Fennville 616-561-2164 or **Auto Zone**, 183 W. 32nd St., Holland, 616-355-5401 to check their hours for dropping off used motor oil. Don't mix other wastes with oil.

## OTHER MATERIALS

**Large shipping cartons, foamed polystyrene** (no packing peanuts), **appliances** and **tires** can be taken to the monitored depot site: Salem Township Transfer Station near Burnips on 29th St. 1/4 mile South of 142nd, on the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month from 9am to 3 p.m. You must present your resource recovery card.
