## Cardboard

Break down cardboard boxes and cut or fold into 3ft. squares and stack under the recycling bin. Place bin within 6ft from road edge where bin is visible.

Place items out the **NIGHT BEFORE COLLECTION.**

**Do not place material in bags!**

**Paperboard**—Cereal snack & tissue boxes, remove liners, no wax coated paperboard and gable topped cartons.

**Junk Mail**—Envelopes, flyers, brochures, post cards.

**Magazines, Phone Books & Catalogs**  
**Cardboard & Paper Bags**—No wax coated cardboard.

**Glass**—Empty clear, green or brown glass.

**Metal**—Cans must be rinsed out, empty aerosol containers, foil.

**Plastics**— #1 thru #7 plastic bottles and jugs empty and rinsed out, plastic grocery bags #2 & #4.

**NO Styrofoam & Batteries!** Read below in other materials to find out where these are accepted!



Call the Allegan County Health Department if you have **Household Hazardous Waste**, like: **household batteries, oil-based paints, cleaners, expired or unwanted medications, pesticides,**

**solvents, compact fluorescent lights, automotive and other chemicals.** Bring us your **mercury thermometers** for an exchange! Appointments for drop off are available on Tuesdays and Thursdays during regular business hours. Call 269-673-5415 for your appointment.



**Used motor oil can be recycled!** Call **Fennville Tire Center**, 205 W. Main, Fennville 616-561-2164 or **Auto Zone**, 183 W. 32nd St., Holland, 616-355-5401 to check their hours for dropping off used motor oil. Don't mix other wastes with oil.

## OTHER MATERIALS

**Large shipping cartons, foamed polystyrene (no packing peanuts), appliances, tires, household batteries** can be taken to the monitored depot site: Allied Waste Services, 3310 M-40, Hamilton on the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month from 9am to noon. You must present your resource recovery card.
